## We Should Know!

A group of Zionists decided to honor Hardwig Peres on his eightieth birthday. The decision was made last June.

What better tribute could be paid to such a man as Mr. Peres as founding a colony in Palestine to bear the name "Peres Memphis Colony." Thirty thousand dollars is needed to complete this project. It was the consensus of opinion that the general public would respond to such an appeal in just recognition of the long years of service that Mr. Peres has given to every worthwhile organization in the city.

At a single meeting of the Executive Board of the Memphis Zionist District approximately \$2,000 was raised for this purpose. Then the drive was postponed. First came the Welfare Fund—then other emergency campaigns, and the drive came to practically a stand-still.

But this is also an emergency measure. As Dr. Stephen S. Wise has so forcefully stated: "We are not a race of beggars, and we must not be made into a nation of refugees". The place for the oppressed Jews is in Palestine, and just as the force of public opinion changed Great Britain from scrapping the Balfour Declaration-so will this same force, make Great Britain open the doors of Palestine for the Jews.

But they must have land—a place to live, and before the price of land becomes exorbitant, we Jews must buy as much land as humanly possible.

A campaign committee has been announced. Abe Plough heads the committee as chairman. Fred Goldsmith is treasurer and Louis Kotler secretary. Plans have undoubtedly been made, but we believe that these plans should be made public at once. After all, the time set for the celebration is January 5-which is slightly more than a month from the present

The Peres Colony will form a part of the solution of the great problem of resettlement of Jews. Not just a temporary plan or make-shift measure—but actually a permanent solution of the Jewish Problem.

#### GOEBBELS DEFINES NATIONAL SOCIALISM

According to the latest ordinance, in liquidation of Jewish enterprises, remaining stocks, damaged during the wrecking operations of Nov. 10, must be offered to respective commercial or industrial organizations at a price fixed by estimators appointed by local chambers of industry. Sale to the public is forbidden.

## **NEW ANTI-JEWISH DECREES MAY** BE FATE OF GERMAN JEWRY

Unless Democracies Evacuate German Jews At Once, New Horrors Will Be Added

Berlin (WNS)-Unless the democracies evacuate the German Jews at once and at their own expense, they will be starved into crime and then exterminated with "fire and swort." This is the lurid picture of the fate confronting German Jews as splashed across the front page of Schwarze Korps, organ of the Gestapo (secret police) and Hitler Elite Guard, which together dominate the German domestic situation. The first step toward carrying out the plan which the Nazi organ outlines will be a new anti-Jewish decree issued by Field

ing issued in rapid succession—will be concentrated.

The new decree, it is understood, will create definite ghettos by compelling the Jews to live in certain restricted districts in a number of cities, probably 25. At the same time they are to be excluded under pain of punishment from certain parts of cities in which they will be permitted to dwell such as Berlin's government district, and from other cities such as Potsdam, Weimar and Berchtesgaden they will be banned entirely.

Elimination of Jews from German business life is being effected in a series of sweeping decrees issued by the government, one of which orders complete liquidation of all Jewish retail stores, mail order enterprises, commission houses and handicraft shops. The decree, signed by Economics Minister Walter Funk and Justice Minister Franz Guertner under the personal direction of Goer-ing, is expected to be followed by similar orders eliminating Jews from their few remaining positions such as in industry and the wholesale trade. Compelled to pay salaries up to the first of January, Jewish-owned business enterprises must neverthe-

In order to collect the 1,000,000,000-mark fine imposed on the Jews as punishment for the murder of Ernst vom Rath, the government decreed a 20% capital levy on the property of all German and stateless Jews possessing more than 5,000 marks. Foreign Jews were specifically exempt, although German Jews living abroad must pay on their domestic and foreign properties as well as those who reside in Germany.

> GOERING SCORES EXTRA-LEGAL OCTION AGAINST JEWS; 1500 CHILDREN GO TO NETHERLANDS

> Berlin (WNS) -Field Marshal Hermann Goering told thirty-six Nazi district leaders that he would hold them personally responsible for any extra-legal action against Jews, sources close to Field Marshall Goering said he explained to the party leaders who were called to Berlin to consider the economic situation, that the time for street action against Jews was over and that anti-Jewish decrees already issued were regulating the "Jewish problem."

In the meantime Jekish leaders expressed fears that a one billion mark government levy against Jews would make their emigration virtually impossible in the next nine months, Jew-ish quarters were extremely worried after studying the decree issued yesterday, by which the Jewish fine will be collected in four installments, ending August 15, 1939.

CARL FROMM, 45, WAR-TIME GERMAN AVIATOR, DIES HERE

East Orange, N. J. (WNS)-Dr. Carl Fromm, engineer and aviator who during the World War bombed Paris and London from a Super-Gotha plane, died here in St. Mary's hospi-tal after an abdominal operation two weeks ago. Forty-five years old, Fromm, was born in Dueren, Ger-many, graduated from the University of Aachen with a doctorate in mechanical engineering and was teachdiscussed "Europa" and Europa in "Limbo", both of which deal with troubled current European affairs.

Dr. Briffault twice won the Military Cross for bravery. It was in the trenches that he began his first book, "Psyche's Lamp."





The Jew generally suffers first, because he seems to epitomize the ourest and most uncompromising form of the anti-absolutist tradition of western religion. But as soon as the Jew is disposed of, the Mosque and the Church, which are associated with him in the struggle for rightousness, suffer his fate.

This fact, so fundamental for an anderstanding of current events, is in part obscured by the tendency of arrogant absolutists to hide behind a facade of religion so long as it suits their purpose. But sooner or later, they find the appearance of loyalty to any form of the Prophetic Tradition a heavy burden, and cast it off, like an evil spirit fleeing before the Name of God. Either, like the German Nazis, they declare open war on their faith; or, like certain medievalists, they defile the Temple itself and make the institutions of their religion the means for the achievement of their anti-religious purposes.

England now stands between a Fascist Europe and the non-Fascist rest of the world, last, greatest bulwark against the spread of Fascist ideologies. Should they win this island, their road lies open, not only to the British Empire, but to the entire world. British Jews thus stand vigil now over the defense not only of their own interests, but also of those of entire world Jewry Their action is therefore of import

The exceptional importance of England is recognized not only by the Jews, but also by the Nazis, and they are now concentrating their greatest effort on winning a foothold in this country. This is done with the aid of secret subsidizing of various anti-Semitic activities, publications and organizations; of the latter the official British Fascist party is by far not the most important and most dangerous. Mosley's organization is too well-known and too much suspect of official propaganda to have too wide an influence. Of greater danger are the various bodies and publica-tions which are not known directly as Nazi or Fascist and which therefore exert a greater influence. One hears very little of the British blackshirts in England of late. Yet, anti-Semitic propaganda, both in print and in speech have increased enormously during the last six months. 

must ever again be compelled to touch soil over which the German flag has been lifted up. Moreover, we Jews do not believe in reprisal or in vindictiveness. We do not wish even the German people to believe that we desire to possess ourselves of lands of which they have by war been dispossessed. Moreover, any Jewish oc cupied one-time Germany colony would become, that is, its destruction would become the supreme objective of Germany. We would have Jews live anywhere outside of the Nazi Reich, live under almost any condi-tions, but we will never give appro-val or sanction to any plan which dooms Jews to live again in a land defiled up to the days of peace by that government which has sought to destroy them. I would rather have my fellow-Jews die in Germany than live somehow, anyhow, in lands which bear the imprint of yesterday's occu-pation by Germany in leads which pation by Germany, in lands which may tomorrow be yielded back by England and France to Germany."

If England wishes to help German Jews tolive, it can do the following things, Dr. Wise asserted: "It can admit Jewish children into England. It will take such action as the President of the United States has taken with regard to temporary resident of German refugees. It will cooperate genuinely with the Intergovern-mental Committe for Refugees, un-der the leadership in part of two great Americans, Ambassador Myron Taylor and Director General George Rublee, in establishing temporary, transient homes or hostels for Jews of Germany, tens of thousands of them pending their ultimate distribu-tion among the lands, the provinces; the dominions, nations and continents which they will ultimately be in

"But the one great, indeed supreme service that England can render the Jewish people, the whole Jewish peo-ple, not merely German Jews, is at once, without a moment's delay, to grant the request of the Jewish popu-lation of Palestine thatthey be perlation of Palestine thatthey be per mitted to welcome ten thousand Jew ish children out of Germany, anothe ten thousand Jewish adolescent another eight or ten thousand rela tives in German lands. In one word, England can do most today for Ger-man Jews by opening wide the doors of Palestine."

Such an action will win the sup port of world opinion and indeed the conscience of mankind. He said, it Great Britain fails to take the large steps, "to give home not refuge, to German Jews in Palestine, all else that it contemplates and proposes and announces will be in vain and the sincerity of English concern will be questioned."
